Krkonoše Mountains was declared the National Park mainly due to its unique arctic-alpine tundra on the ridges, significant marks of glaciations and harsh climate, subarctic peatbogs, large forest vegetation and mountain meadows. Only here there is vegetation of Krkonoše rowan tree, Campanula Ceca (Czech bluebell) and a lot of endemic hawkweeds. The mountains are also home of the Northern lynx and the nightingale Bluethroat.



Man and nature

Krkonoše Mountains National Park in numbers:

- The altitude 400–1,602 m above the sea
- The average annual temperature 0–6°C
- Number of the embryophytes species 1,300
- Number of the vertebrate species 240
